






































SUSTAINABILITY REPORT: SDG 5 2024



BAAU aims at encouraging a considerable number of girls to choose such fields. Each year BAAU organizes several events or meetings with schools in order to motivate girls to study IT, Math, Physics. Not only career service

employees are involved in such events, but also BAAU invites successful women in those spheres by which a number of girls selecting these areas are increasing year by year.

BAAU has childcare facilities for staff and faculty. Baku Eurasian University provides both staff and faculty personnel and students who are parents with an on-campus **childcare center**.

Baku Eurasian University provides both staff and faculty personnel and students who are parents with an on-campus childcare center.

With the growing demand for childcare provision, there is a recognition that such provision must be of a suitably high quality. Quality childcare can benefit children, their parents (employers and students) and communities in general.

It is obvious that parents or students can hesitate whether or not to return to work and study after the birth of a child. One way is helping alleviate the stresses involved in choosing a childcare provider is by providing on-campus childcare by Baku Eurasian University. An on-campus childcare center has been proven to help working and studying parents better focus on their work and study, boost their productivity and promote a healthy work/study-life balance. Undoubtedly, it is helpful in terms of reduced absenteeism and tardiness of colleagues and students with children.

A childcare center is provided with indoor and outdoor space and meet licensing requirements, state regulations as well. Besides, furnishings, toys, snacks and cleaning supplies are stocked on an ongoing basis. Also, hiring qualified caretakers is strictly regulated by BAAU Recruitment Code. This service is offered hourly, daily, weekly depending on parents' need. It is important to mention that this childcare center is not run as a kindergarten.

In terms of building and child security, security technology has been installed around the university building and facility staff is regularly trained for emergencies.

Overall, the childcare facility aims to:

- √ help reduce employee absenteeism and tardiness;
- increase productivity, engagement and morale among employees;
- ✓ be used as a recruitment and retention tool;
- encourage employees/students to return to work sooner after the birth of a child;
- ✓ promote work/study-life balance;
- allow employees/students to check on their children throughout the day and allow breastfeeding mothers access to their children;
- ✓ frame the institution as an employer of choice;
- increase retention of students with children and increase ontime graduation rates.

BAAU has women's **mentoring schemes**, in which at least 10% of female students participate. The female mentees have the opportunity to learn from the experiences of the mentors for their upcoming career start, to exchange ideas and to network with the participants in this program in the long term.

BAAU has a policy that protects those who report discrimination from educational or employment disadvantage. It is the policy of Baku Eurasian University to maintain an academic and work environment free of discrimination and harassment for all students, faculty, and staff.
